#1 Class Rule Changes and Policies

C.2.3 DIVISIONS

(a)Age / Gender Divisions in World and Continental events
Ages are identified as from the 31st December in the year of the competition
i. U13 Division: boy or girl under the age of 13 years old
ii. U17 Division: boy or girl under the age of 17 years old
The minimum age for the U17 Division shall be specified in the Notice of Race with a one-year overlap with the U13 Division.

#2 Class Rule Changes

C.2.3 DIVISIONS

(c) The U13 Division shall use the Dacron 3.5 sqm sail and the U17 Division shall use the Monofilm 4.5 sqm sail as supplied by a licensed manufacturer. For national events the Notice of Race may specify the use of the Monofilm 4.5 sqm for the U13 Division.

#3 Title and prizes policy

Boys and Girls of a Division shall race together with a general score to identify the overall champion of each Division. Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 boys and top 3 girls in each division.

C.4.2 Advertising by the organizing authority is permitted in accordance with World Sailing Regulation 20.4.1.5; this advertising shall be placed immediately below the bottom batten, on the central part of the sail, at the same position on both sides of the sail. 3.5m2 sail - 0.4375m2
4.5m2 sail - 0.5625 m2
